THIS INNOVATIVE PROJECT AIMS TO ADDRESS THE LACK OF GREEN SPACE IN URBAN ENVIRONMENTS WHILE REPURPOSING UNDERUTILIZED SPACES FOR COMMUNITY BENEFIT. THE PARK WILL FEATURE LANDSCAPED GARDENS, SEATING AREAS, RECREATIONAL FACILITIES, AND COMMUNITY GATHERING SPACES. SCAFFOLDING WILL PROVIDE THE FRAMEWORK FOR ELEVATED WALKWAYS, OBSERVATION DECKS, AND SHADED AREAS. COLLABORATIONS WITH LOCAL RESIDENTS, COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS, AND CITY AGENCIES WILL ENSURE THE PARK MEETS THE NEEDS AND PREFERENCES OF THE SURROUNDING COMMUNITY, FOSTERING SOCIAL COHESION AND WELL-BEING.
