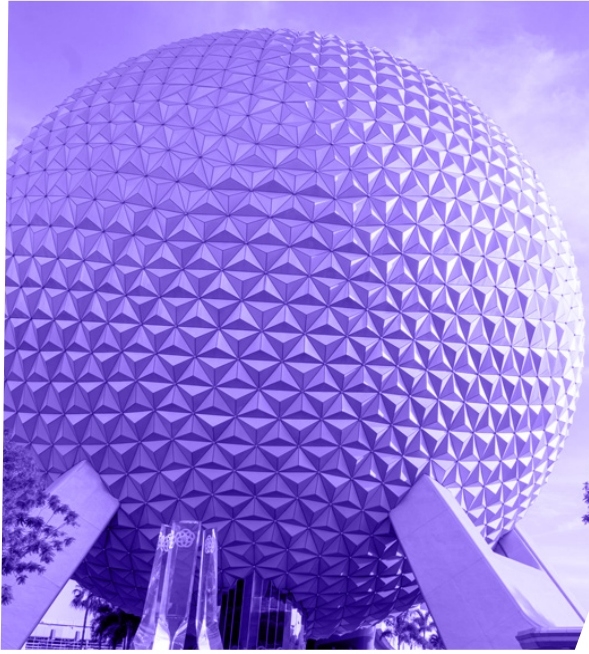

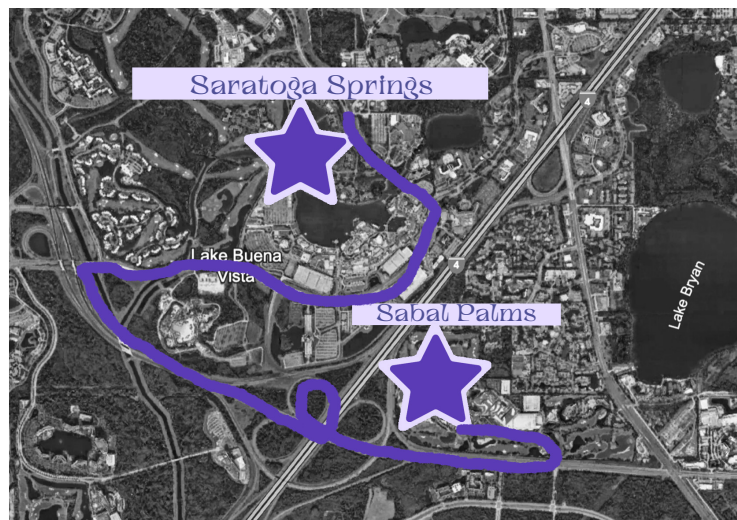

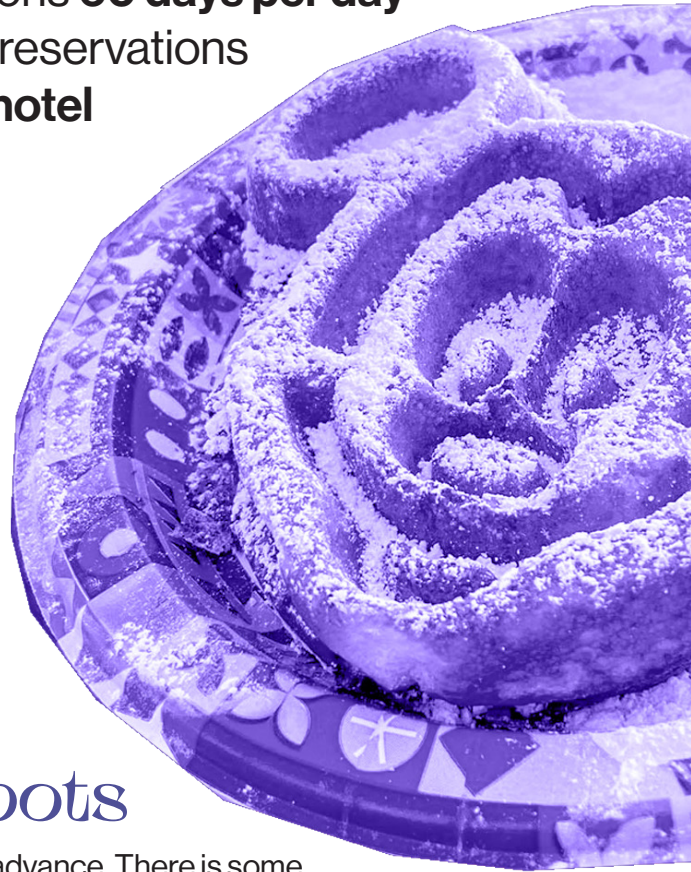

Dining

Dining Reservations can be made **60 days in advance**. If you are at Sabal Palms, you can make your reservations **60 days per day of park reservation**. If you're on property, reservations are made **60 days from the start of your hotel check-in day**.

For example, if you are staying at Sabal Palms, you are able to make reservations on a **day by day basis**. So if you are 60 days out from the Magic Kingdom, you can make a dining reservation. If you want to make one for Epcot, the day after Magic Kingdom, you'd be unable to **until the next day**.



Require Reservation Spots

A lot of these spots will be hard to snag without booking way in advance. There is some walk-in availabilities but it's highly recommended you book these at the 60 day window if you want to eat there.

App Overview

The “**My Disney Experience**” App is your ticket to everything you’ll need for the duration of your trip. Magicbands, your tickets, hotel information if you’re on property, wait times, and dining information. Here is the stuff we think you’ll use the most!



Home Screen

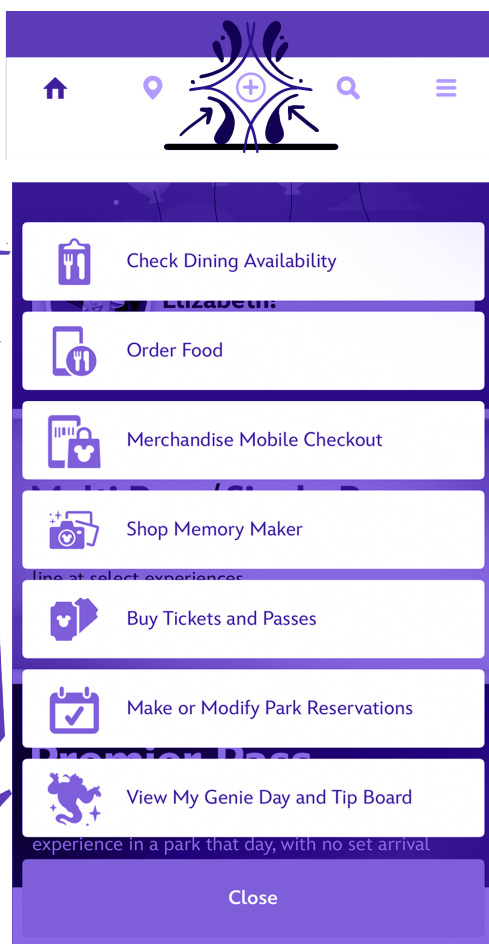
The **plus sign** at the bottom of the app opens a list of the most important things you’ll need!



This is where you’ll make most of your dining reservations as well as check for any last-minute walk-up availability! You’re able to search by park, by time of day, and by availability.

Here you’ll be able to mobile order food. While you’re heading to a spot, check if they have mobile ordering. Usually it’s faster, and by the time you get to the location you’ll be able to skip the line and get your food quicker.

This function is a bit weird. Genie attempts to optimize your day and suggests rides for you. Provides a list view of the wait times in alphabetical order. If you purchase Lightning Lane, you will be making your selections here! I don’t recommend Genie, solely because I’ve never used it.

Lightning Lane Multi-Pass is the paid version of Fastpass. Its divided up into Tiers' some parks have Tier A and Tier B rides, with all parks having at least one ride that requires a seperate purchase (Single Pass). You are allowed to prebook one Tier A and two Tier B passes, which you can then continue to book after you've used them in the parks. The multi-pass can run around 15-30\$, it just depends on crowd levels.
