











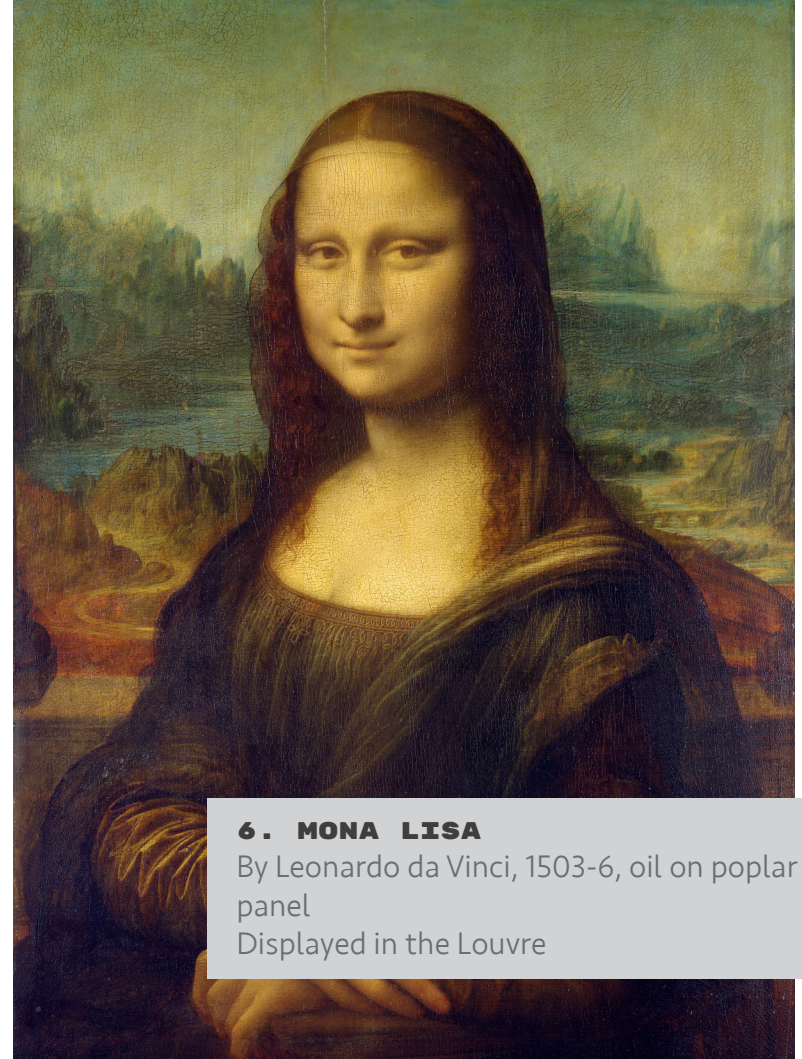


VANDALISED :

- March 10th 1914, Mary Richardson slashed it 8 times with a meat cleave, provoked by suffragette Emmeline Pankhurst's arrest. She stated, 'I have tried to destroy the picture of the most beautiful woman in mythological history as a protest against the Government for destroying Mrs Pankhurst, the most beautiful character of modern history.'

VANDALISED :

- Leading to bulletproof glass installation, a man claimed to be in love with painting and attacked it with a razor blade
- December 30th 1956, Ugo Ungaze Villegas, a Bolivian man, threw a rock at it and chipped some paint from the left elbow of the subject
- April 21st 1974, a woman spray painted the glass in the Tokyo National Museum to protest the places inaccessibility for the disabled
- August 2nd 2009, a Russian woman threw a porcelain teacup at the glass, upset at being denied French citizenship
- May 29th 2022, a climate activist disguised as a woman in a wheelchair threw cake at it
- January 28th 2024, two people from Riposte Alimentaire threw soup at it
