

Light, fast, smart. Designed lucky. A virtuoso of modern XC. Efficient. Responsive and supportive. Rabbit.


The Pedaler.




Racing to win. That is it. If a high schooler racing in the NICA series has enough resources this is the bike he or she should be on.

Goal: Easy to Maintain

Race-Lite suspension is a single pivot flex-stay suspension. We eliminated the traditional pivot in the chainstay by using flexible seat stays. Two less bearings and pivot hardware mean lower weight, simplified construction, and less maintenance.

Internally molded tubes make routing cables super easy, and the ports stay covered if you don't use them.




Goal: Pedaling Platform

Race-Lite suspension helps the frame to have a more sturdy pedaling platform while retaining excellent sensitivity to terrain keeping traction during hard pedaling efforts. It relies on the seat stays flexing throughout the travel.

We use the flexing stays to add progression to the end of the shock stroke for a bottomless trail feel in just 115mm of travel. This also allows for shock air pressure to be set lower.

The flex has been tuned to minimize stress on the seatstays. The seatstays start out in a pre-flexed state and achieve their static position around sag. They then continue to be stretched outward until the suspension reaches full compression.

Chain stay and seat stay triangle starts in compression and ends in tension.






Goal: Laterally Responsive

We chose a CNC alloy rocker instead of compression molded carbon because at this scale it is stiffer and lighter. The shape is optimized for weight saving and stiffness. An alloy rocker also means bearings are pressed into the rocker rather than the seatstays for easy servicing.





Goal: Strength to Weight

Carefully optimized frame shapes maximize frame stiffness and minimize weight. Elimination of redundant material through smooth transitions between tubes brings the frame to a. Accent lines have been smoothed and optimized to assist in stiffness.

Frame Weight: 1700g

Goal: Matching the Modern XC Course

Long dropper post insertion with appropriate length seat tubes gets people in a primed descending position. A slacker head tube and longer reach then the previous Signal offers better stability on the descents of modern XC courses.






